WORKLOAD UPDATE

Environmental workload is consistent with last year with not much change going forward. Salon, pool and restaurant licensing renewal forms will be going out within the next few months, pending reopenings affected by covid-19.

PROGRAM UPDATE

Phep and MRC programs are continuing; especially due to the volume of work on the Covid-19 pandemic. Other grant programs are on hold right now and will be addressed at a later date.
