RED CROSS IMPACT In the aftermath of severe weather that caused severe flooding across parts of Connecticut, Red Cross volunteers continue to bring comfort and support to their neighbors.

Since August 18, the Red Cross has provided support to impacted communities; providing 3100 meals and snacks, delivered emergency supplies to 220 families, including clean-up kits and other supplies, have been distributed to people in need. To date, these relief operations have been supported by more than 70 trained Red Cross disaster workers.
